The New Mayflower Primary School

Although no dates have been agreed, we <u>might</u> be able to move in at the beginning of the spring term 2024 (08.01.24). <u>If</u> this can be achieved, school will remain in session until **Friday 22nd December 2023**, and then go into recess.
