When we upload to your child's Learning Journal, you will be instantly notified via an alert. You can then access this, and hopefully provide a comment as well! In this way, together, we will be creating a very special record of what your child has achieved, as well as the incredible amount of learning that has taken place!

Of special note is that Tapestry allows parents to upload to their child's Learning Journey as well. We can then comment on what they have done, and learn a little bit more about their experience outside of school. One of the real advantages of this is that we can then build on their learning experiences within our setting. To the child, this makes learning an integrated process that takes place throughout the day! From personal experience, we know how much a sense of belonging is achieved by joining home and parents together and this makes a direct contribution to the safety and security that they feel within themselves, their home, and their setting.
